Linear Park / New Entrance to St. James Hospital

Dear Resident,

On-site works are progressing well; the next three-month look-ahead summary will be issued to local residents later this week.

BAM is constructing a new public pedestrian entrance from the linear park to St. James's Hospital adjacent to Fatima Luas stop. This new entrance will be constructed by BAM in approximately 3 weeks. St. James's Hospital has obtained a licence from Dublin City Council and Bam have an agreement with St. James's Hospital to extend the compound area.

As this new entrance nears completion and some of the existing hoarding is removed, the hoarding will be extended along linear park to the Rialto Luas stop where it will tie in with the existing site hoarding. This will take a further approximate 3 weeks to construct.

A number of trees which will be within the newly constructed hoarded area (i.e. new compound) will have to be removed. This will commence this week and continue into next week. This is included in the permission granted to SJH by DCC Parks Department. Bam will purchase the same amount of trees at a nursery where they will grow for the next few years and be planted at linear park after the hoarding / compound is removed.

There is an existing temporary pathway (approx 1.5m wide) along the outside of the existing hoarding. This will be extended, at a width of 2m, along the new hoarding up to Rialto Luas stop.

Bam is mindful of the footfall along linear park, in particular the amount of school children traversing from the SCR Kilmainham direction to the three local schools in Basin Street. In this regard, site flagmen and signage will be in place to facilitate during hoarding construction.

Bam Civil confirm works will take place between the hours of 0700-1900 Monday – Friday and 0800-1400 on Saturday (we advise that Saturday work will be kept to a minimum).
