DCC Planning Department have granted BAM permission to extend their working day by three hours to 10 pm to carry out "Facade Works & Low Level Noise operations" on Tuesday the 20<sup>th</sup> and the 27<sup>th</sup> and Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> of July .

The work involves setting out work stations for the following day, essentially cranes moving slabs and cladding material around the site for the following days work and removing waste from the previous days work. The work is deemed low noise and crane based and should have minimum impact on surrounding communities.

We expect that if this case is proven that the work is quiet and has minimal impact BAM will seek a continuous extension to their work day up to Christmas (or possibly for the duration of the build) for four days a week.

We have been advised by BAM that there should be no impact on anyone as there should be no evidence of noise or additional light pollution either from the site or as workers enter or leave the site after 7.00 p.m (the official closing time)
