**Temporary Change to Rialto Hospital Entrance**

Dear Resident,

You may have noticed over the past few weeks that the new children's hospital construction team have been constructing a localised modification to the existing Rialto entrance. This work is nearing completion and the temporary modified entrance is expected to open on Monday 9<sup>th</sup> April.

Traffic Management personnel will be in place on Monday to assist vehicular and pedestrian traffic to familiarise themselves with the modified entrance. Pedestrians will be required to cross the road at the pedestrian crossing as shown on the drawings below and follow the directional signage to access the western side of Brookfield Road/SCR junction. This arrangement will be in place for approximately four months at which time the existing entrance point will reopen. Please note there will be four car parking spaces taken up on Brookfield Road to accommodate this temporary arrangement as agreed with Dublin City Council. We ask that you please follow the directional signage and guidance from traffic marshals during this period. Please stay on designated pedestrian routes and crossings at all times. Thank you for your cooperation in this regard.
